Hotel Customs

1 Check In





Please produce your passport/ID when you check in as we are required to take a copy. (by hotel law article 6.)

2 Your Room



Take off your shoes before entering the room.



Slippers are for use outside of your room only.



Please refrain from dragging your luggage across the Tatami as Tatami damages easily.



Please understand that the Tokonoma is an area for decoration only and refrain from using it.



For safety, items such as wet towels should not be put directly on the heater. Please use the towel rack provided.



For safe keeping please put your valuables in the safe provided.





You will find our complimentary items in the drawer. Yukata -dressing gown, Haori-room jacket, bath towel, toothbrush, and face towel. Feel free to keep the toothbrush and face towel.

3 How to Make Green Tea







Put the tea bag into the tea pot.

Add hot water from the hot water pot provided.



After about 1 minute the tea is ready to serve.



Remove the tea bag and put on the dish provided. (You can use one tea bag about 5 times.)




Please eat the tea cake freely.




Feel free to wear your Yukata and slippers around the hotel.

Meal Times








Meals are served in the restaurant (not in the room). Please come to the restaurant at your appointed meal time.
