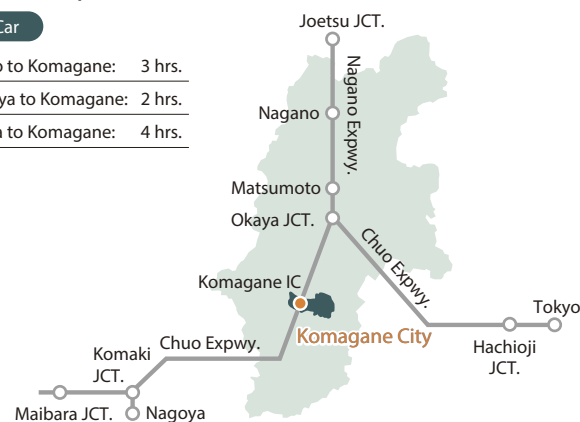

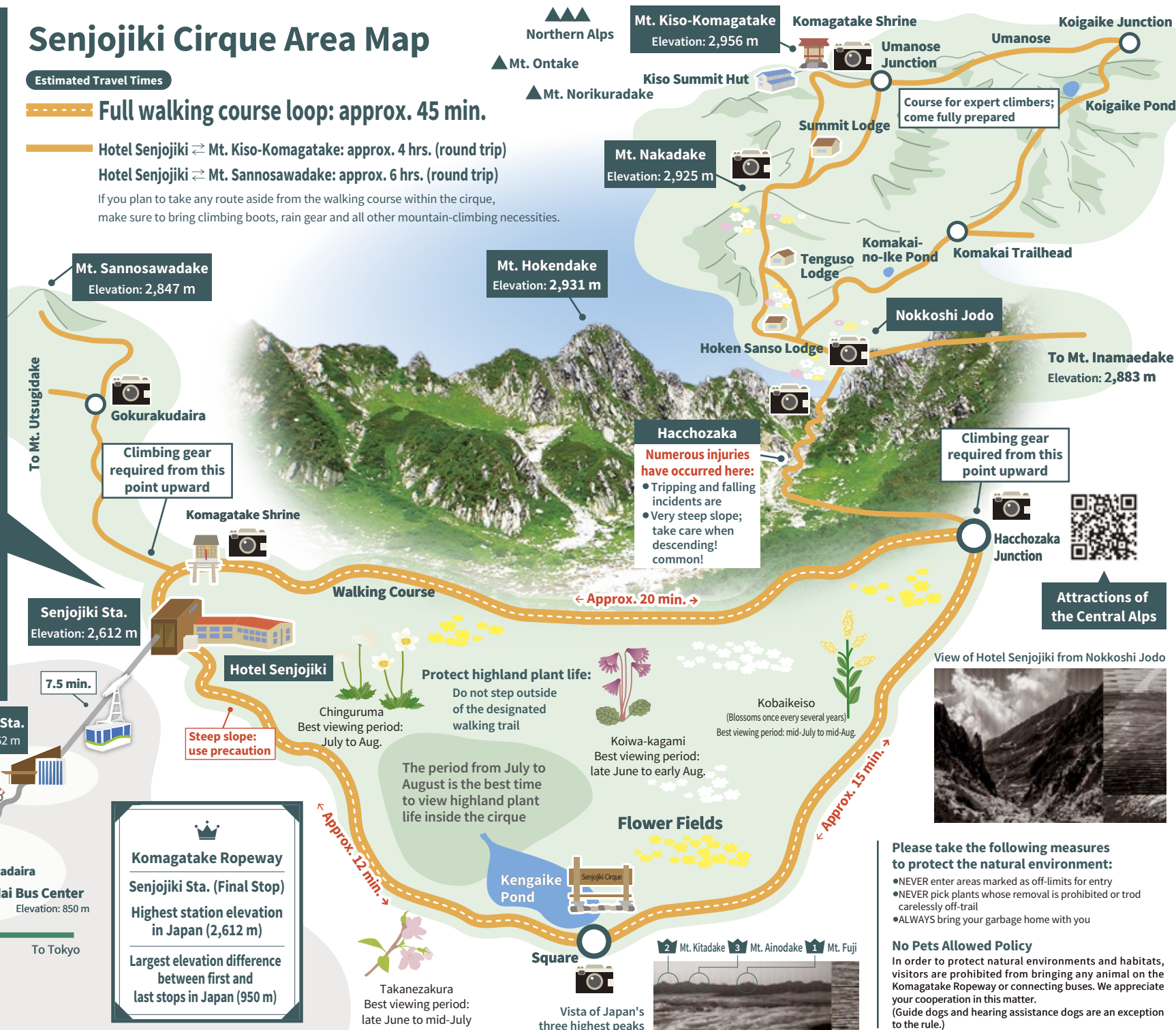
Estimated Travel Times

 **Full walking course loop: approx. 45 min.**

Hotel Senjojiki ⇄ Mt. Kiso-Komagatake: approx. 4 hrs. (round trip)

Hotel Senjojiki ⇄ Mt. Sannosawadake: approx. 6 hrs. (round trip)

If you plan to take any route aside from the walking course within the cirque, make sure to bring climbing boots, rain gear and all other mountain-climbing necessities.



Please take the following measures to protect the natural environment:

- NEVER enter areas marked as off-limits for entry
- NEVER pick plants whose removal is prohibited or trod carelessly off-trail
- ALWAYS bring your garbage home with you
